

Fitness Application Filing Fees

A filing fee is required when submitting the Fitness Application. See Part A, Section 4(a) of the [Rules Governing Admission to the Practice of Law](#).

All fees must be in the form of a Money order or
 Bank Cashier's Check
 made payable to the Office of Bar Admissions

Regular fees and late fees may be combined in one Money Order.
 Applications are not considered filed until all required fees have been paid.

*Fitness Application for the two-day examination filed prior to the award of the first professional degree in law	\$300
*Fitness Application for the two-day examination filed between the award of the first professional degree in law and within one year thereof	\$450
*Fitness Application for the two-day examination filed more than one year after the award of the first professional degree in law	\$600
*Fitness Application for the one-day Attorneys' Examination	\$800
Fitness Application for Admission on Motion without Examination (Must be filed simultaneously with Petition for Admission on Motion)	\$800
Petition for Admission on Motion without Examination (Must be filed simultaneously with Fitness Application)	\$500
Fitness Application for Recertification of Fitness	\$100
Fitness Application for Readmission (pursuant to State Bar Rules)	\$2,500
Fitness application for Reinstatement (pursuant to State Bar Rules)	\$600
Application for Foreign Law Consultant	\$1,000

*Fitness Application for the two-day examination filed between the award of the first professional degree in law and within one year thereof	\$700
*Fitness Application for the two-day examination filed more than one year after the award of the first professional degree in law	\$800
*Fitness Application for the one-day Attorneys' Examination	\$1,000
Petition to determine eligibility for Admission on Motion without Examination (must be filed simultaneously with Fitness Application)	\$600
Fitness Application for Admission on Motion without Examination (must be filed simultaneously with Petition for Admission on Motion)	\$1,000
*Fitness Application for Readmission following disbarment by the State Bar of Georgia	\$3,500
*Fitness Application for Readmission after the expiration of five years from the effective date of voluntary resignation from the State Bar of Georgia	\$1,000
Fitness Application for Readmission within five years from the effective date of voluntary resignation from the State Bar of Georgia	\$800
*Fitness Application for Reinstatement following termination from the State Bar of Georgia due to non-payment of dues	\$1,000
Fitness Application for Reinstatement following suspension from the State Bar of Georgia due to non-payment of dues	\$800
Fitness Application for renewal of certification (Recertification)	\$400
Fitness Application for Foreign Law Consultant	\$1,000
